Rules and Guidelines

- **Event Description:** Chili Cook-Off contest featuring family-friendly live music, great food and exciting fun in Riverfront Park, Historic Cocoa Village.
- The Entry Fee for the Chili Cook-off is \$25. **Checks made payable to Cocoa Village Chili Cook-Off.**
- This is a Community Event...!! You may sell fundraising items such as hats, T-shirts, pens etc, or hand out information leaflets at your booth. These items **MUST** be kept separate from all food items and serving areas.
- We actively encourage creativity - show your spirit....bring your supporters...dress in costume...!!!! Participants will be showcased in pre-event publicity..!
- Show spaces are 10X10. We provide tables and electricity, but please bring your own extension cords.
- There are no cooking facilities available, so entries must bring their chili already prepared from their health-inspected facility. You may use canned fuel such as Sterno® to re-heat your chili's.
- You are responsible for supplying all serving utensils, serving cups and spoons, chafing/warming dishes, gloves, sanitizing supplies and any other implements required for serving.
- We recommend small taster or soufflé cups for your Chili samples.

- **Arrival:** 11:00-12.00. Public event begins at 1pm.
- **Volume:** This is a competition that includes public tasting. You must prepare and have your chili ready to serve for public tasting when the gate opens to the public at 1 pm. A minimum of 6 gallons of chili is recommended for public tasting.

- **Categories:** - Best of Show (People's Choice), Hottest Chili, Most Unique Chili, Best Vegetarian Chili, Best Display and Most Enthusiastic Team.

- **Judging:** The public will be able to taste and cast their votes for the 'Best of Show ', 'Best Display' and 'Most Enthusiastic Team' Awards throughout the afternoon. There will be an independent judging panel for the awards of 'Hottest Chili', 'Best Vegetarian' and 'Most Unique Chili'. Prizes will be presented on stage at 4.45pm.

- **Prizes:** Winners will be highlighted across all media formats after the event...!!
People's Choice 'Best of Show' prize - \$100 plus a Trophy guaranteed to boost your bragging rights for 2010....!!
Second Place - \$50 plus a wonderful FLAMING plaque.
All other prizes - Chili Cook-off FLAMING Plaque.
