From the Beaches: Take A1A to State Road 520 for 7 miles, left onto Brevard Avenue.

From the Mainland: Take US1 to State Road 520. East on 520 for 1 mile. Turn right onto Brevard Avenue.

From the Mainland From Interstate 95: Take Exit 201 East onto State Road 520 for 4 miles. Turn right on to Brevard Avenue.

From Interstate 4: Exit east onto 528 to US 1 (40 miles). Turn south 3 miles to 520. East for 1 mile and turn onto Brevard Avenue.
